### 1. DATA PROTECTION AT A GLANCE

#### GENERAL INFORMATION

##### WHO IS RESPONSIBLE FOR DATA COLLECTION ON THIS WEBSITE?

### REVOCAION OF YOUR CONSENT TO DATA PROCESSING.

### RIGHT TO OBJECT TO DATA COLLECTION IN SPECIAL CASES AND TO DIRECT ADVERTISING (ART. 21 DSGVO\*)

## 4. DATA COLLECTION ON OUR WEBSITE

### COOKIES

- Some of the web pages use so-called cookies. Cookies do not cause any damage to your computer and do not contain viruses.
